Project WET Workshop

Where: **Agapé Center for Environmental Education** near Fuquay-Varina

When: Saturday, **August 28, 2010**, 9:00 a.m.-3:30 p.m.

Credit: This 6-hour Workshop provides credit for both **NC EE Certification** and partial **CEU** upon completion.
