What: ACE Education is excited to offer “ACE Ed-Ventures,” a special opportunity for home school groups and families featuring special topics for children K-8.

Where: The Agapé Center for Environmental Education (ACE Education), located about 10 miles SW of Fuquay-Varina in Harnett County on the Cape Fear River.

When are the “ACE Ed-Ventures” events?

All events: 9:00 a.m. - 12:30 p.m. Bring a picnic lunch & stay until 1:00 or so...

- February 17 – Bobcats and Foxes and Bears, Oh My! (Predators)
- March 17 – Amphibian Adventure! Waterproof boots required, oh boy! (3rd grade and up) [age limitation due to length of hiking]
- April 23 – Tree Identification
- May 26 – Fishing with Poles and Bowls (Fish and other water life) [Maximum of 20]
- September 15 – History Trail (3rd grade and up) [age limitation due to length of hiking]
- November 17 – Native Americans

How much does it cost?

- \$10.00/person/event. Deposit \$7.00 (*All deposits are non-refundable.)
***With a minimum of 15 participating children, the cost is \$7.75/person/event
- Chaperoning adults \$1.00.
- Balance due at or before event.

Is there a deadline?

Yes. The deadline for registration is one week prior to the advertised event.
