

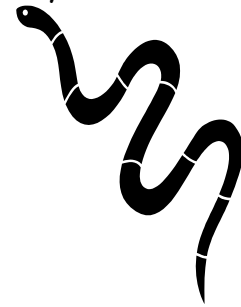
# ACE at Your Place
