The workshops offer educators exciting new activities to use in teaching science, math, language arts, social studies, and environmental studies.
 - Calling Amphibian Survey Program (CASP) workshops are geared toward conservation-minded citizens interested in learning more about frogs and toads.

 - Volunteers from Church Youth Groups, Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, Families, Individuals.
 - A day or two each fall, winter, or spring to help prepare Agapé's trails for hiking and to keep them in good condition to help Agapé carry out its ministry. It's a great service project!
