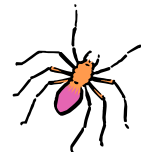
**What to wear:** Dress for outdoors and the current weather conditions. We'll be outside for at least two hours. Optional – bring a water bottle.

What's it all about? Read on!

**September 26, 2009 - Bravo for Bats** The evening sky at Agapé swarms with a variety of the coolest mammals ever! Join Lisa Gatens, Curator of Mammals at the Museum of Natural Sciences and member of the NC Bat Working Group, as she sets mist nets to trap bats for us to see up close before safely releasing them to their work of gobbling up a veritable plethora of night-flying insects. *\*\*This Safari begins at 6:30 p.m. – we'll be 'going batty' until at least 9:00, with the option to stay later.* **Registration deadline: September 23.**

**October 17, 2009 - Outdoor and Survival Skills** Learn how to prepare for outdoor adventures and what survival skills are essential. Build a shelter with natural materials from the forest. Practice your wilderness fire-building technique. Discover ways to get water and food in the woods. *Time: 9:30 a.m.- Noon. Bring a lunch if you'd like to have a picnic afterwards.* **Registration deadline: October 14.**

**November 21, 2009 - Let's Talk Turkey** What animal can run 25 mph, fly 55 mph, is a true native American, and was considered to be our national bird? That's right – the Wild Turkey. There's more to turkeys than just a Thanksgiving meal! Come learn more about the amazing wild turkeys of Agapé. Explore the woods searching for signs of these well adapted birds. Perhaps we'll even get a glimpse if we're quiet enough! Turkeys have keen vision and hearing. *Time: 9:30 a.m.- Noon. **January 30, 2010 - Predators!** Bobcats and Foxes and Bears, Oh My! Discover signs and learn more about these predators and many more that live at Agapé. *Time: 9:30 a.m.- Noon. Bring a lunch if you'd like to have a picnic afterwards.* **Registration deadline: January 27.**

**February 20, 2010 - Nature by Night** God's creation doesn't stop when the sun goes down. Immerse yourself into the secrets of the night as we explore how our senses work in the dark. Sky permitting, we'll also take in a special feature viewing of the winter constellations and learn some American Indian stories of the sky. *\*\*This Safari is 6:30-8:30 p.m.* **Registration deadline: February 17.**

**March 20, 2010 - Frog Festival** It's time for the annual amphibian concert series. Spring peepers! Chorus frogs! American toads! And more!
